# Diversity data

This document provides diversity statistics for those students who commenced the Costs Lawyer Qualification in 2021. The data relates to 23 students who enrolled for the course. 10 students applied for exemptions based on prior learning, allowing them to start the course at either Unit 2 or Unit 3.
